Direction under Section 10(1)(b)(ii)

ACTING under the Section 10(1)(b)(ii) of the Consumer Affairs Authority Act, No. 09 of 2003, the Consumer Affairs Authority directs all manufacturers, importers, distributors, suppliers and traders that they shall not keep, store or stack in any warehouse, store or other premises, any expired items or items which have been identified as unfit/unsuitable for sale and which are kept, stored or stacked for the purpose of destroying/for the purpose of re-exporting unless a register is maintained of such items containing the type of Product, Brand name, Weight/Volume and No. of units.

This Direction shall come into effect from 1st September, 2014.

Direction under Section 10(1)(b)(ii)

ACTING under the Section 10(1)(b)(ii) of the Consumer Affairs Authority Act, No. 09 of 2003, the Consumer Affairs Authority directs all manufacturers, importers, distributors, suppliers and traders that they shall not in any manner whatsoever keep, store or stack any item that has been identified as not fit/suitable for sale or any item that has been identified as expire goods/ unfit for human consumption along with or together with items which are offered for sale, exposed or displayed for sale, in the course of their business

This Direction shall come into effect from 1st September, 2014.
